



## How to choose the right materials for your boat interior?

**Polyester thread vs PTFE:** Polyester thread is always a good option as there is a broad range of colors to choose from. However, PTFE is the most durable option since it preserves the color longer and keeps its thickness after being exposed to salt water and the sun.

**Vinyl vs Synthetic leather:** Synthetic leather is characterized for its nice feeling at touch and it is recommended for areas not directly exposed to the *weather*. Vinyl on the other hand, is recommended to all exterior upholstery because it is more resistant to natural conditions and easier to clean.

**Polyurethane foam** in all its density variants is the most commonly used for marine interiors. Before choosing your foam make sure it is formulated with the right antimicrobial additives to help prevent unwanted effects of microbial growth including mal-odors, staining and product degradation.
